Certified Medication Technicians work in long term care facilities, monitoring and passing medications to patients. Qualified students must have their CNA with 6 months of experience. When the CMT course is complete the Insulin Certification class begins.

REQUIREMENTS (Documentation MUST be provided):

- High School diploma or General Education Development (GED) Certificate 1.
- State certified nurse aid with a minimum of six months nurse aid experience 2.
- 3. Letter of reference from employer (administrator or D.O.N.) or previous employer
- Register with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services by completing and following the instructions on the Worker Registration form, only if you are not already registered.
- 5. Take the D level of the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE). You must score a minimum score of 8.9 on Vocabulary and Comprehension tests and a minimum score of 7.0 on Mathematics Concepts and Application tests. This must be done prior to class starting.
