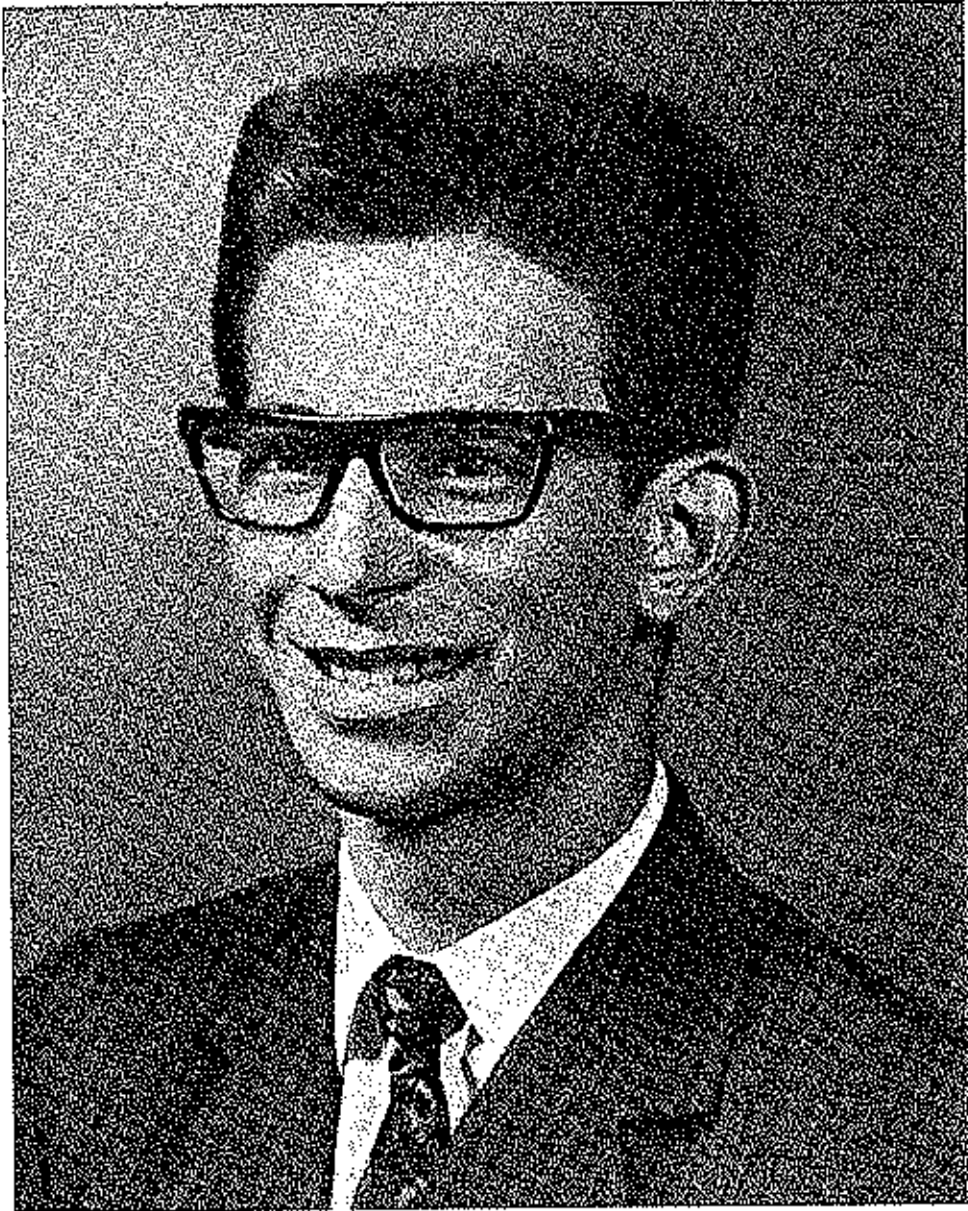
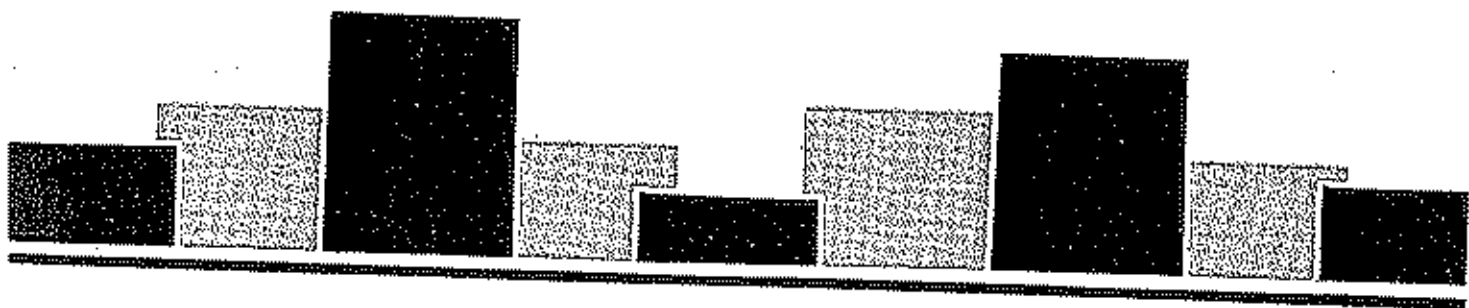


Dedication

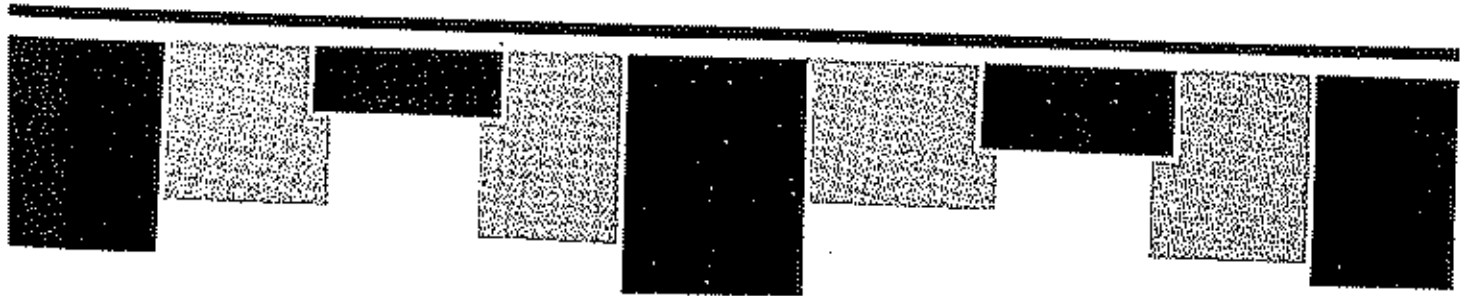


We, the students of Eldon High School, do hereby dedicate this book to our first exchange student from Costa Rica, Lizanius Dolgado:
