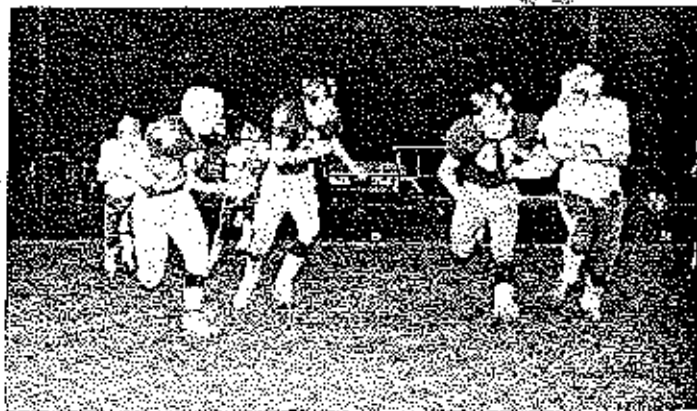

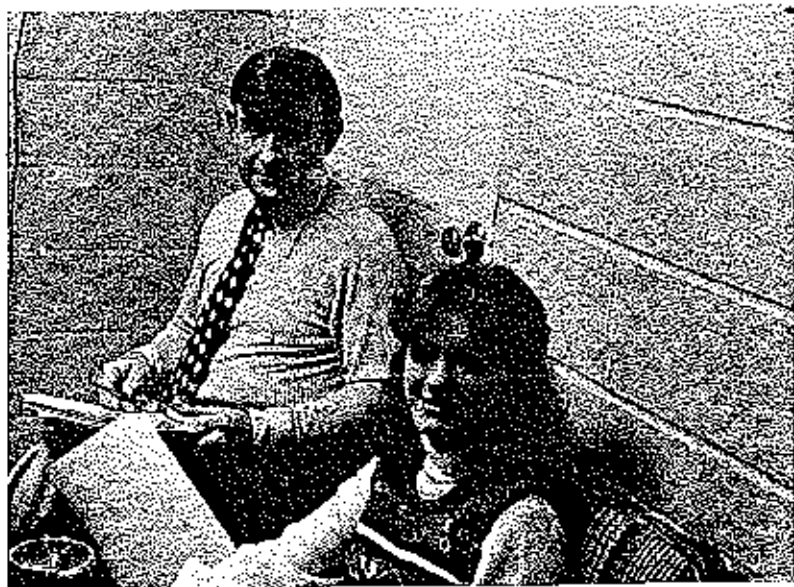

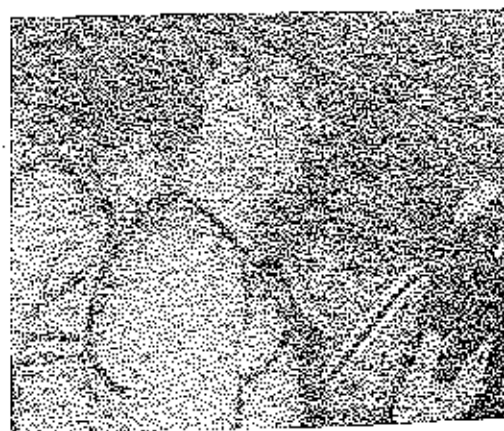

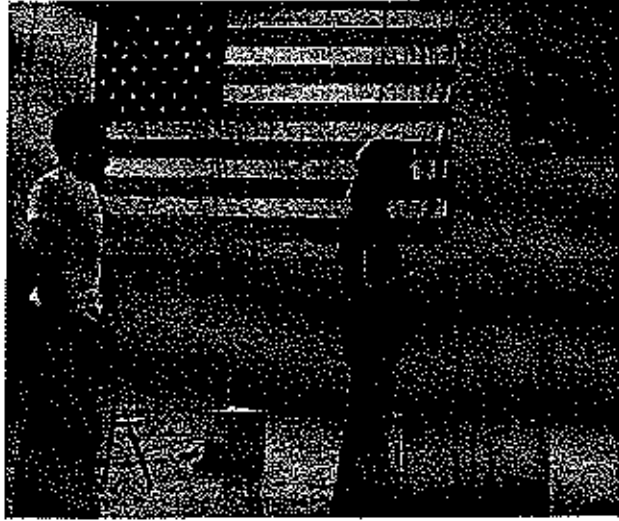

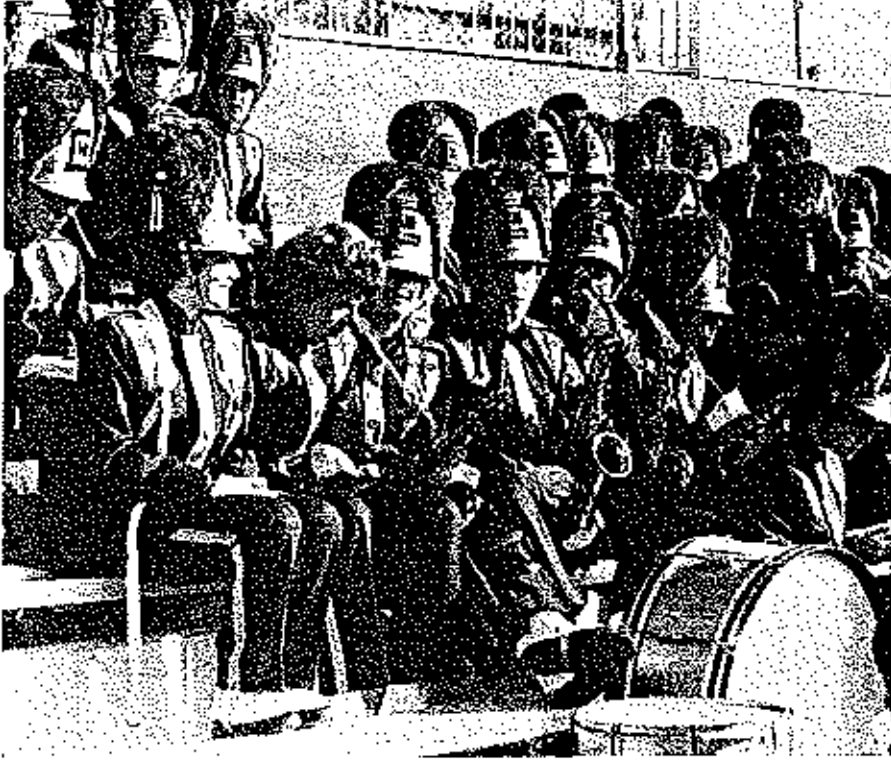

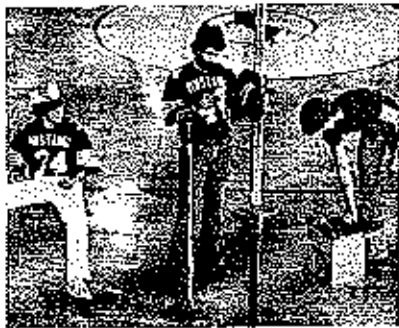

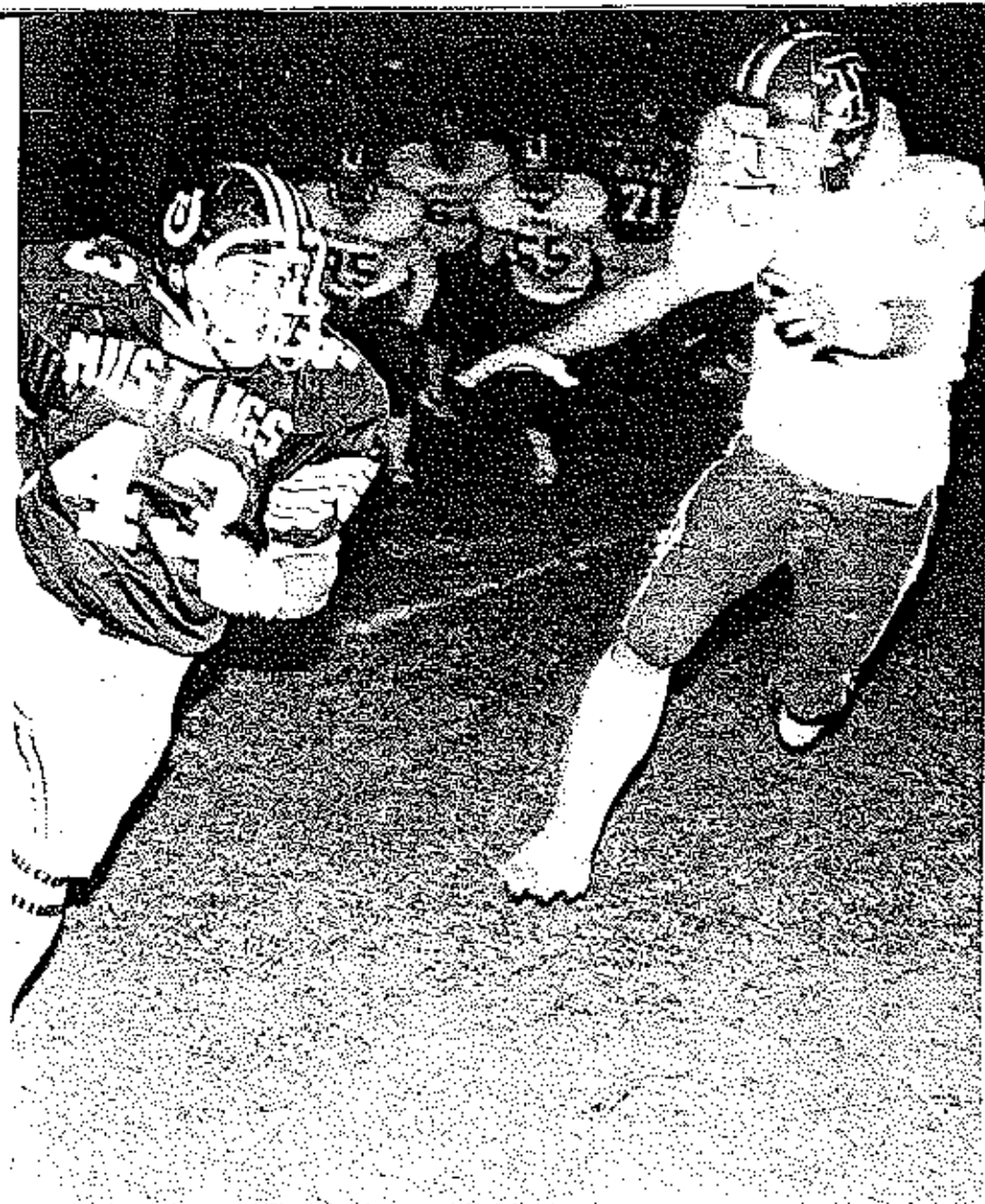

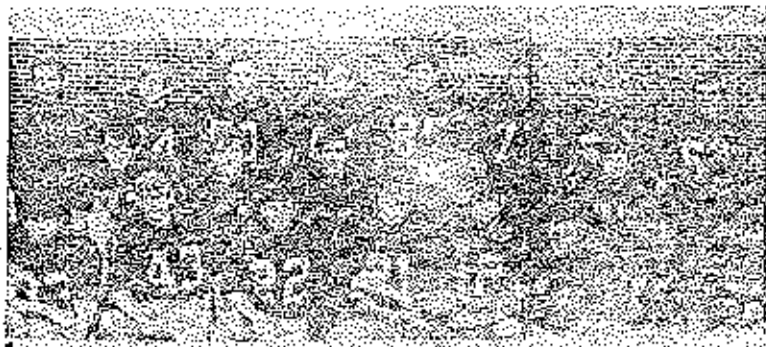

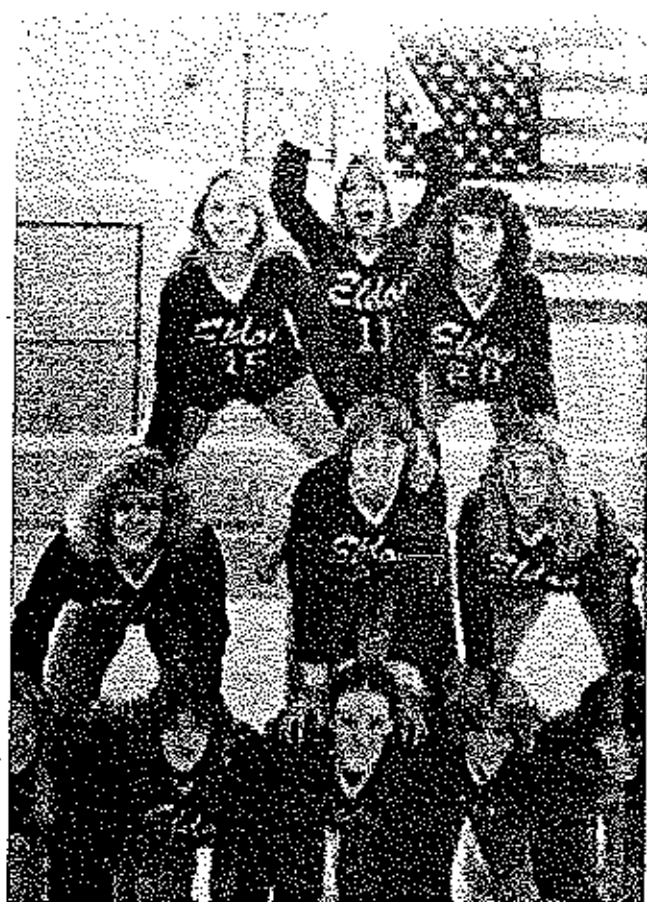

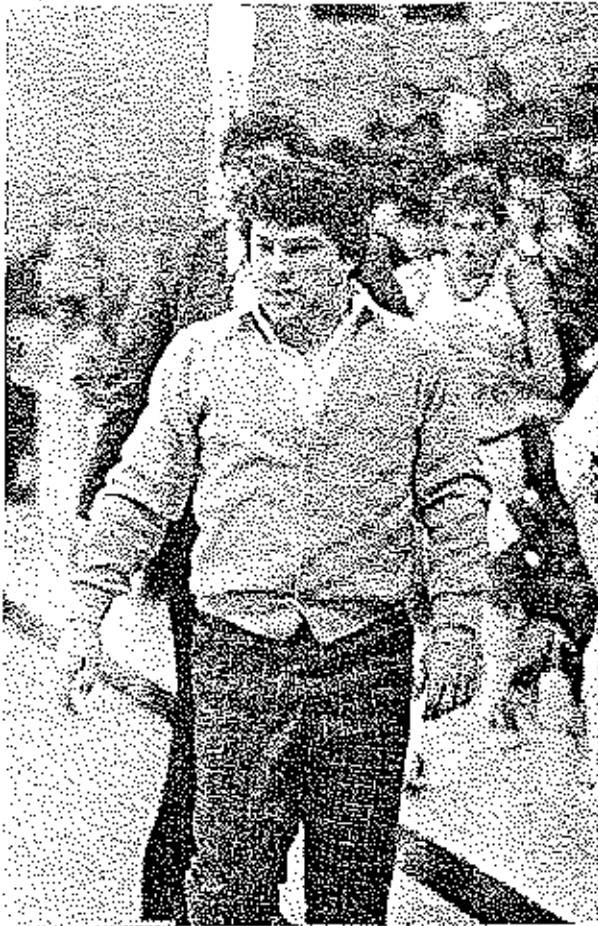

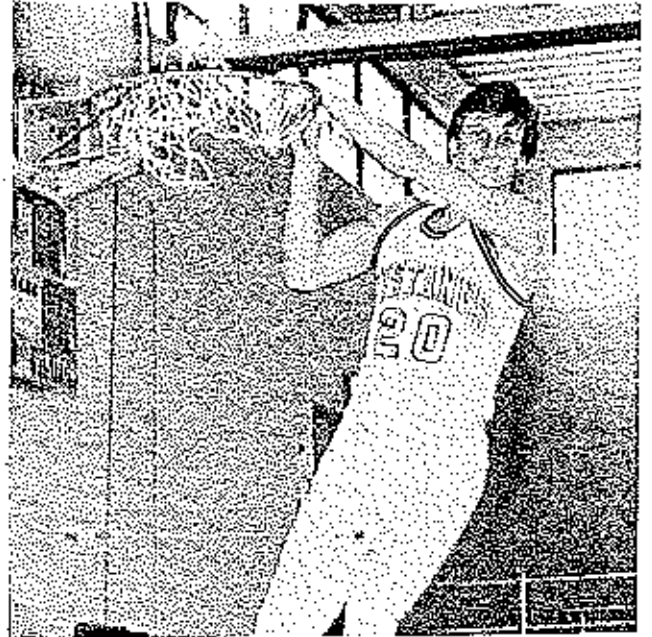

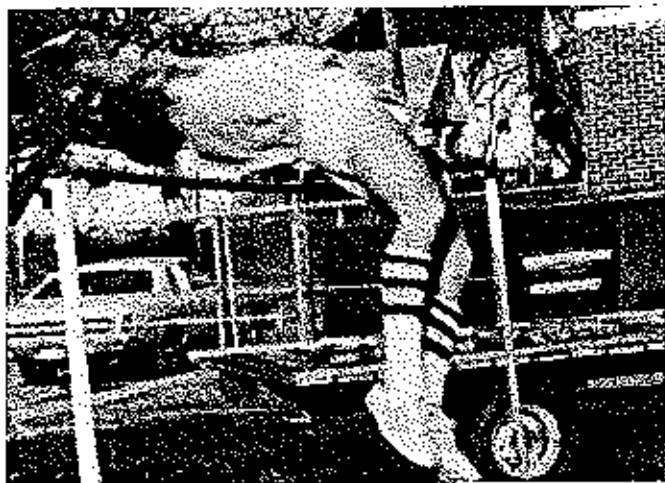
# Boys' Track

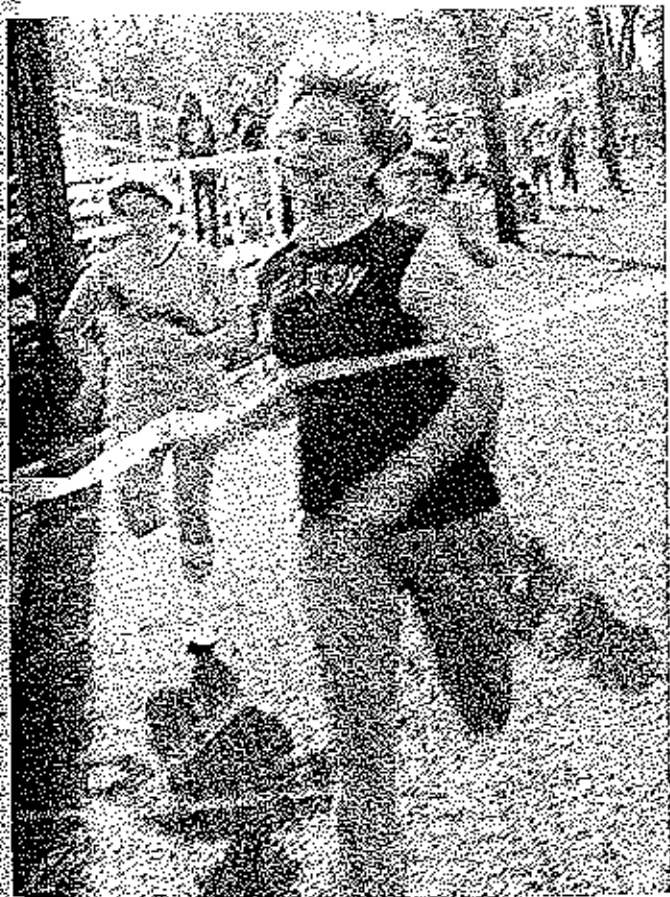

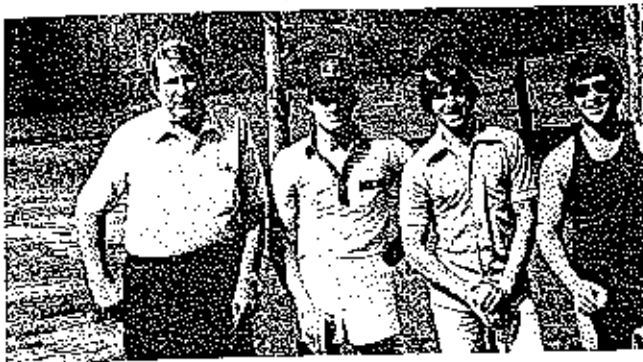

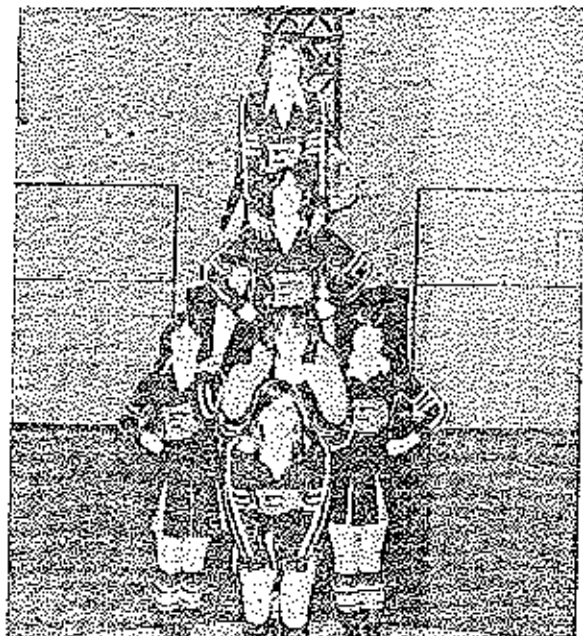

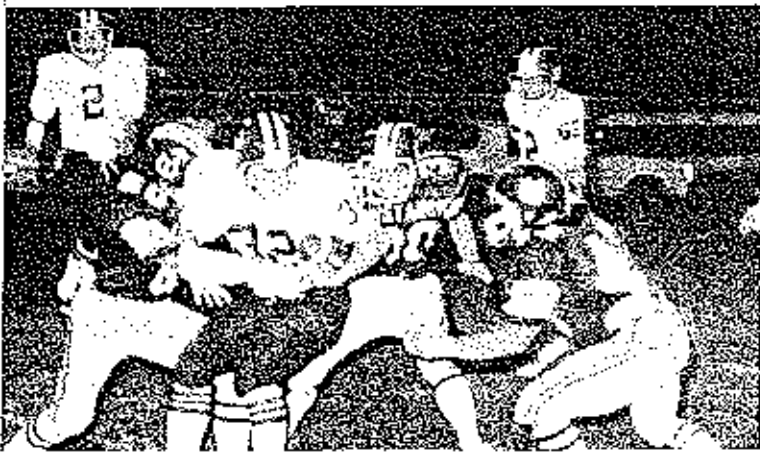

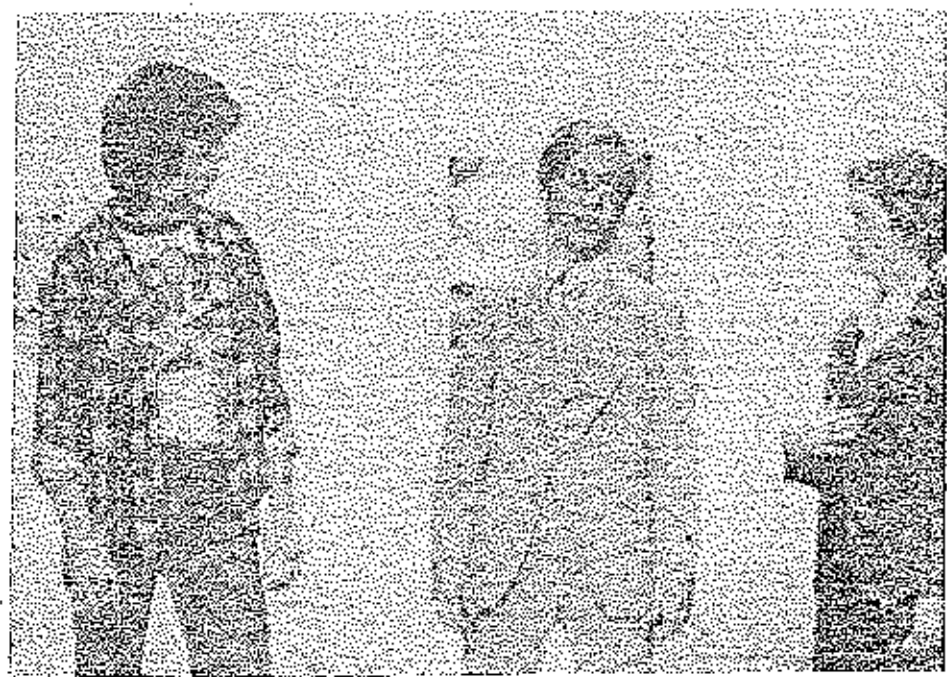

The Home Ec department served cookies and punch.



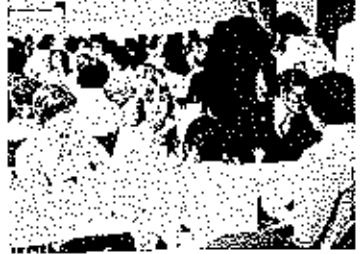
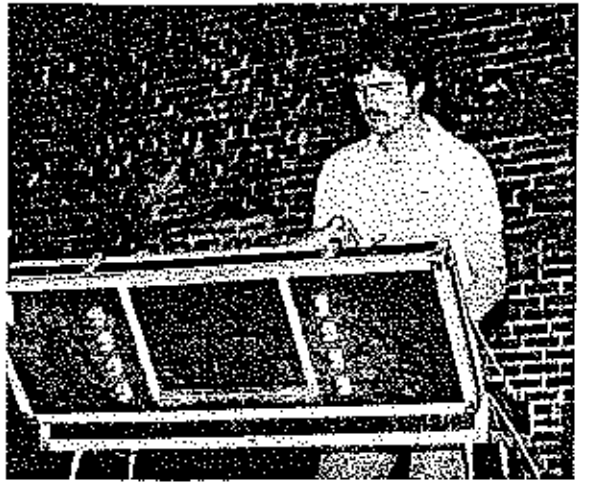
# "Searching For A Rainbow"

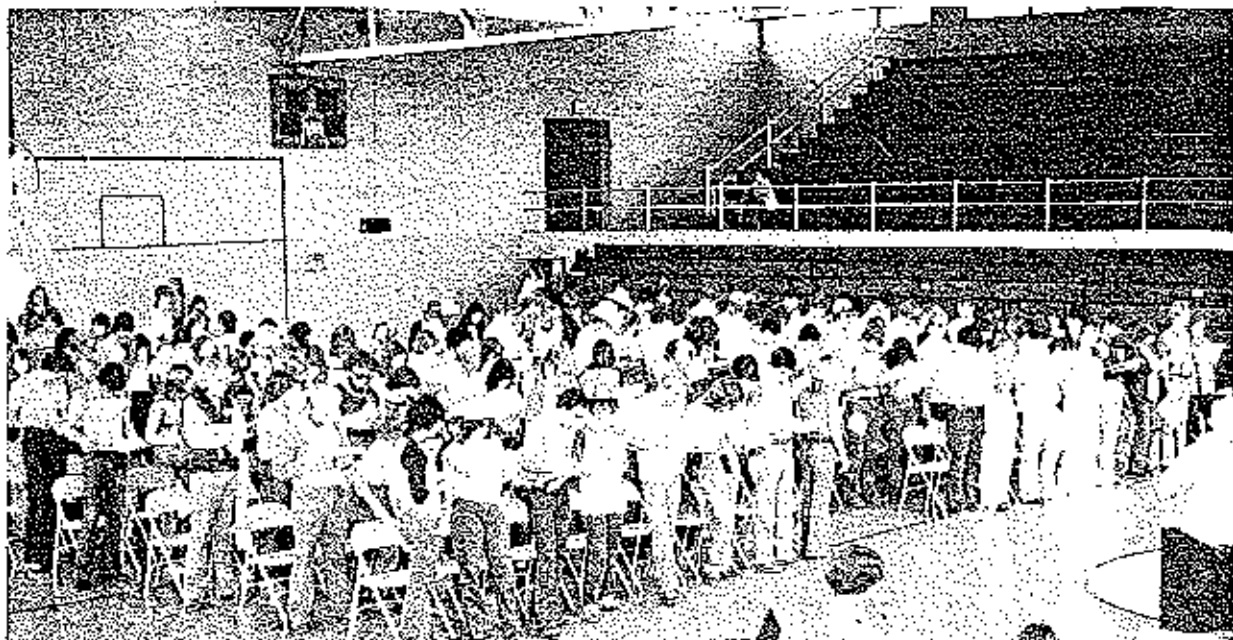

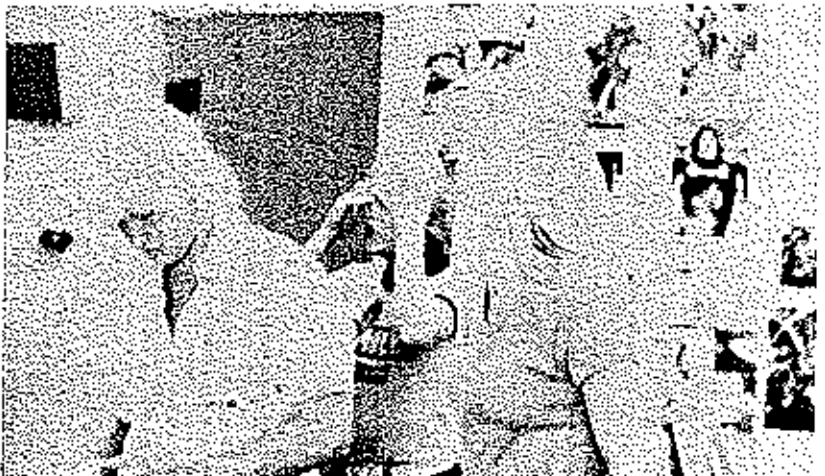


