BOARD MEETING DATE: May 21, 2018

TITLE AND BRIEF DESCRIPTION: Summer School

The Eldon School District has always provided summer school for the students. We know that having summer school for our students is a benefit for them academically. The school district receives reimbursement for providing summer school.

ACTION DESIRED:

Approve summer school that would include one teacher per 15 students, transportation, breakfast, and lunch.

BACKGROUND:

Summer School dates would be June 4, 2018 through June 29, 2018 from 8:00 – 2:30 p.m.

GOALS:

Provide summer school for students to improve their math and communication arts abilities.

Enrichment activities will also be a key piece to summer school this year. The High School will provide classes for credit so that students will have more opportunities for taking elective classes during the regular school year.

This year I am also recommending hiring six students that want to be teachers as interns this summer to work with our teachers and students.

RECOMMENDATION:

I recommend that we have summer school from June 4-29, 2018 with the pay schedule listed below. Teachers that work from 7:30-2:30 p.m. \$2,500, paraprofessionals for \$1,250, bus drivers at \$32 a route, and summer interns for \$960.

The district will still hire some special education teachers to meet the needs of our special education students. The district will also hire special education staff to meet the Extended School Year needs of our special education students Those expenditures will still be reimbursed.

IMPLICATIONS OF ADOPTION/REJECTION OF RECOMMENDATION:

If rejected, the school district will not offer summer school.

If adopted, the district will provide summer school.


TIMELINE:
