BOARD MEETING DATE: February 19, 2018

TITLE AND BRIEF DESCRIPTION: Missouri Registered Apprenticeship Grant

ACTION DESIRED: Approval of the grant that has no local match requirement.

BACKGROUND:

Registered Apprenticeship is a highly flexible “earn while you learn” training model for employment that pays more as a worker (apprentice) reaches higher productivity levels. In addition to rewarding performance, Registered Apprenticeship combines employer-driven job-related instruction with extensive on-the-job learning under the supervision of a trade professional. After completing a Registered Apprenticeship, the apprentice receives a nationally recognized occupational credential that communicates the standards and high level of training that their employer provides.

The Eldon School District is working in partnership with Camdenton School District on writing the grant proposal. Our goal is to hire one person that can work on creating apprenticeship programs in our region.
