



TMK Memorial Scholarship APPLICATION



Description

The TMK Memorial Scholarship Fund was created in 2004, in memory of the late Tom Knoll, a co-owner of Quaker Window Products at the time of his passing to help assist deserving young adults with their educational pursuits. To date the fund has awarded more than \$122,500 in scholarship money to local high school seniors in their pursuit of higher education.

Eligibility

- Applicant must be a high school senior.
- Applicant must have a parent/legal guardian currently working at Quaker Window Products or the applicant must be an employee of Quaker Window Products within the previous year.

Application Process

Candidates must submit the following materials to Jeff Heisler in Human Resources by March 25th, 2022:

- Applicant must complete application form below—type or print information in black ink.
- Applicant must compose an essay of no more than 250 words explaining your goals for the future and how this scholarship will help you achieve this goal.
- Essay must be typed in Arial font, size 12 and attached to the back of this application.
- Applicant must have two references—one personal reference and one teacher reference, along with one letter of recommendation from either one of these references in a sealed envelope.
- Applicant must have a copy of his/her transcript through the 1st Semester (Trimester) of their senior year.

Note: Student receiving award must present class schedule for first semester to receive the award. The award will be paid to the accredited institution of higher learning.
