ASVAB TESTING

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is a multiple-aptitude battery that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic and occupational success in the military and beyond. ASVAB scores thus give students insight into their options and aid them in planning their next step after high school. All juniors take this test, and seniors can elect to take it again if interested in military service.

KIDS HARBOR TEEN SAFETY TRAINING

This program empowers students to spot and respond to bullying, cyberbullying, different types of abuse, and other digital dangers. The Program is based on the latest research and has been reviewed and endorsed by national experts. This training fulfills the MO statute Section 170.045, RSMo to provide abuse prevention training for all students grades.
