### What's the FAFSA??

Any student that plans on attending either a two or four year college must have a parent complete the FAFSA(Free Application for Federal Student Aid). In their English classes, students will be creating their FSA(Federal Student Aid) ID. This is not the FAFSA. It is just the ID necessary to complete it. Parents will also need to create an FSA ID. Counselors will be available at parent teacher conferences if you have questions. The FAFSA will be available to complete in December.

Any senior who has more than 10 days of absences, excused or unexcused; or 12 absences during any one class period either semester, including 8th hour, will not earn the privilege of walking at the graduation ceremony.
