



Scholarship Criteria:

- Resident of Miller County
- Parents are Miller County Farm Bureau members or are willing to join
- Planning to attend a college or technical school to begin in the fall
- Agriculture background preferred or active membership in an organization that supports agriculture (i.e. 4-H, FFA)
- First priority will be given to applicants pursuing an agriculture major (other areas of study will be considered)
- Fully completed application received by April 15.

This is a one-time, \$250.00 scholarship. A panel of Miller County Farm Bureau board members will verify qualifications and choose the scholarship recipients. The funds will be paid directly to the respective student account at the Institution the student is or will be attending upon verified enrollment. The scholarship may be applied toward the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other needs associated with a student's education in the selected field.
