# 2025-26 HEAD START

## **ALUMNI - HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP**

### **SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:**

1. The nominee must have attended Head Start for one or more years.
2. The nominee must be scheduled to graduate from high school, be pursuing a post-secondary education, and submit name of institution of higher education that they are enrolled in or have the desire to attend. These funds may be applied to the documented cost of tuition and/or books.
3. Candidate must submit **two letters of reference**. (20 points)
  - *Letter of reference from someone who knows the candidate as a student (school personnel preferred).*
  - *Letter of reference from someone who knows the candidate as a community volunteer.*

***Applications that do not include two references will not be considered for this scholarship.***

1. **Please share key details about the candidate and family connection to Head Start and current educational environment.** (20 points)
2. **Describe candidate's volunteer contributions to Head Start, Early Head Start, or the community.** (30 points)
3. **Provide a description of candidate's educational and professional goals.** (30 points)
