SUMMER SCHOOL ENROLLMENT 2025

Purpose: To provide an opportunity for students to participate in classes during the summer to enhance their skills in the core subject areas.

Calendar: Classes Begin at 8:30 AM and Dismiss at 3:00 PM each day.
May 28th - First Day of Summer School
June 24th - Last Day of Summer School

A limited number of classes per grade level will be available for students. DEADLINE TO REGISTER - April 11th (Students registered after April 11th will be added to a wait list and enrolled as openings become available.)

Attendance: Students will be allowed a total of three (3) days absent, with three tardies counting as one absence. Elementary students with more than three (3) absences may be dropped, if not previously approved through the office. Students who have 95% attendance or above (missing no more than one full day) will receive a \$40 Walmart gift card at the conclusion of Summer School. Students who miss the deadline to enroll and are added from the wait list after the start of the program will **not** be eligible for a gift card.

Discipline: Students will be warned upon first and second incident of misconduct and upon the third incident the student will be dropped from summer school.

Food Service: A nutritious breakfast and lunch will be provided free of charge daily to all children in the area through the Missouri Department of Health Summer School Food Service Program.

Meals will be available to all children under the age of 18 and to people 19 and older who are determined by a state or local agency to be mentally or physically disabled.

Meals are made available to participants through the U.S. Department of Agriculture without regard to race, color, national origin, gender, religion, age, disability or political beliefs. Breakfast: Breakfast will be served free of charge from 8:00 – 8:30 AM.

Lunch: Lunch will be provided free of charge every day of summer school. Students may eat school lunch or bring their lunch. Students will not be allowed to leave school grounds during the lunch break.

Transportation: This summer's plans are for limited bus routes. At the time of enrollment please note whether or not your child (children) will ride a bus. Enrollment for summer school will be confirmed and sent home to you. Approximate pick-up and drop-off times for South Elementary will be stated. Students who attend and do not ride the bus must be picked up at 3:00 PM each day.

AM LEAP (6:45-8:00 AM) – available for students in **ALL** grades with drop off at South Elementary. Students will be transported from the South Elementary campus to their designated school.

2025 Summer School transportation will be limited bus routes for the entire district. Designated stops will be available in your area. We want to make sure all students arrive at their afternoon destinations on the correct bus. Please read the bus descriptions attached and fill out the form below. Bus riders in K-2nd grades will be dropped off at South Elementary School. Upper, Middle, and High School students will then be transported to their buildings.

4. No offensive language or disruptive behavior
5. No food, candy, gum, or beverages on the bus
6. No large equipment, animals, skateboards or other equipment on the bus
